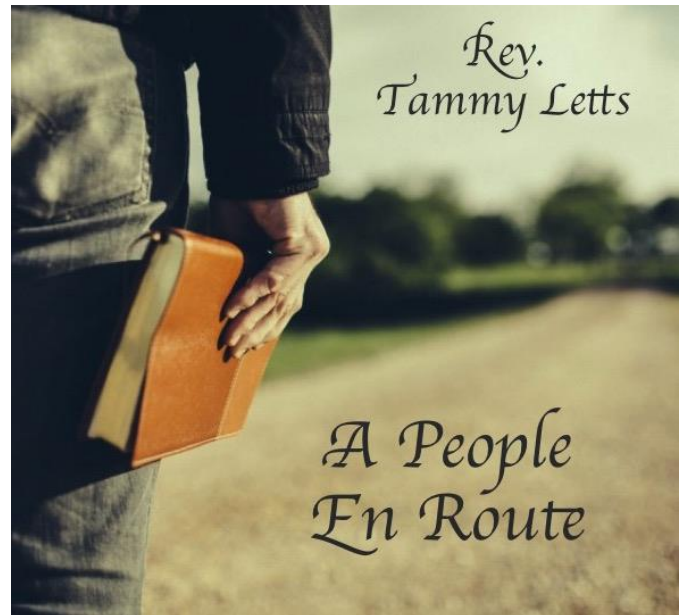

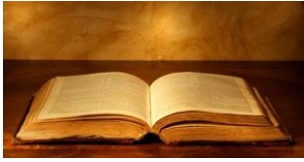

JOY After School

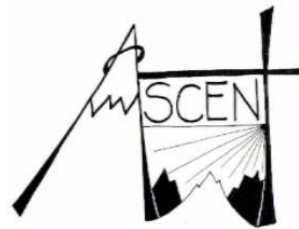
