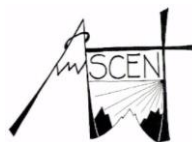

### **Little Lambs Preschool**

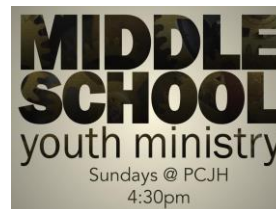
