MISSION & OUTREACH

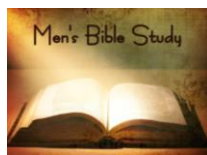

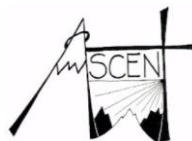

Little Lambs Preschool

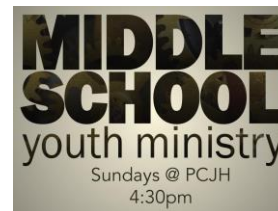
