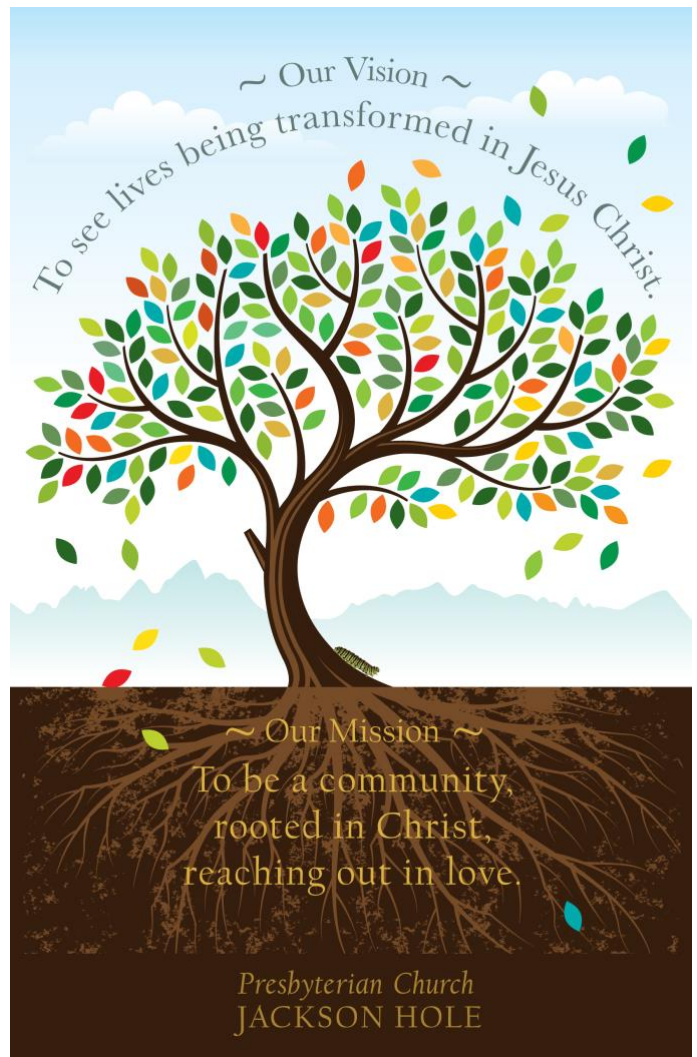

Piece Makers Quilting

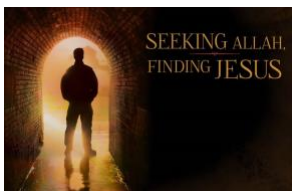
Saturdays from 9am-4pm
