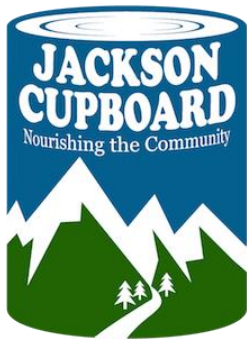

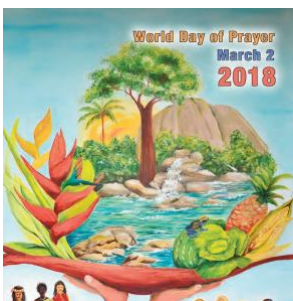
Cross Country Ski Group
