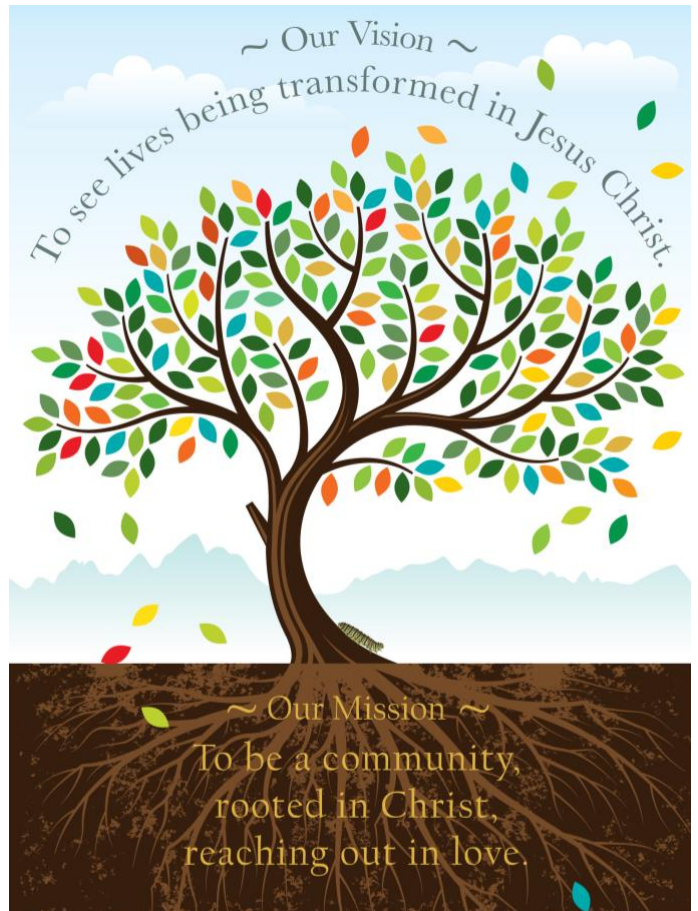
Thoughts for Reflection
