This program will be offered to middle school students entering 6th-8th grades in the fall. Your child will explore God's Great Outdoors right here in Jackson Hole. They will go on adventures throughout the valley; learn the value of building relationships with Jesus, peers, younger J.O.Y. campers; and serve the community all while having FUN!

One week your child may be learning about sports and good sportsmanship, playing tennis, or swimming. ★ The next week your child may delve into the wonderful gifts God gave us in artistic ability: painting the Grand Teton one day; writing character stories the next; and molding clay (as God ★ molds us) the next day, led by a variety of community artisans. ★ The next week he/she may participate in a traditional Vacation Bible School on the church campus, with station rotations. The next week each student may venture out into the Tetons for a ★ Grand adventure - exploring geologic formations, tracking, using a compass and learning how God created this amazing place in which we live. Service in our community is a weekly occurrence. Some days we will be completely off campus, some



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we will leave mid-day for excursions and some we will remain on campus, rotating through activities including arts and crafts, storytelling, puppetry, science, faith learning, academics, games and recreation or special projects. The preschoolers, with half-day (3 yr olds) or full day (3&4 year olds) options, will be on a similar schedule with shorter rotations throughout the day and recess. The 3&4 year olds will have nap/rest-time as part of their afternoon. Each week will be packed with opportunities to play, grow, have fun, and learn in a variety of ways.

ENROLLMENT

All enrollment forms will be accepted online via our website: www.PCJH.org.

It is our intent to give priority placement to families who are members or regular attendees of the Presbyterian Church of J H ministries: Advance Registration begins MARCH 1st.

To our friends in the community at large: Registration begins MARCH 9th.

We will work on a first-come, first-served basis within the prioritized schedule noted above. Space is limited!

CHANGES

Changes to a registration can be made before 5:00pm April 30th, 2014 without penalty. Changes will be accepted via letter or email. CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations made after April 30th, 2014 are subject to the following policy: Cancellations will be refunded only if the opening can be filled, minus a \$5.00 per day processing fee.

PAYMENTS

A \$50 non-refundable enrollment fee per camper is required at the time of registration.

Payment is required with registration. Two options are offered for payments: pay in full at the time of registration or pay 50% at registration and the remaining balance by May 31st. Remaining balances not paid by May 31st will be processed on the first business day in June with the credit card you have provided online. All other requests for scheduled payments must be made in writing and pre-approved by the CYF Administrator, Diane McGee.
