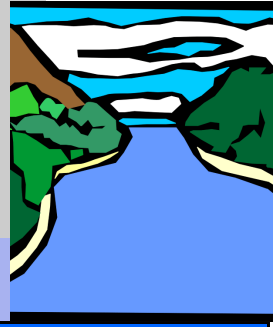

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PARENT TIME

In the hectic pace of everyday life, it can be easy to lose track of important conversations with our kids. It feels like we should reserve a huge chunk of time on our calendars and mark it "Talk to my kids about important stuff." But kids rarely cooperate with our scheduled attempts at open communication. Instead, maybe we should work towards developing a natural family rhythm that leaves room for questions and conversations. If we consistently have a family meal together, our kids will learn this is the time the family talks together. Or, when we prioritize tucking our kids (even our big kids) into bed every night, they will learn this is when they can talk to us about what they're thinking. A consistent rhythm of togetherness will lead to more natural communication.
