I hope you will make time to find a place for your ongoing spiritual growth this winter and spring. If these offerings don't work for you and you have a specific time and place that would, let me know and I will see if we can put a group of GROW-minded people together.

My prayer for us as part of God's family is that we will deepen our love for our Lord and find practical ways to share that love with those whom we are privileged to touch. Keep your staff, Elders and Deacons in your prayers as we strive to lead the people of God.

Epiphany, God's Show and Tell Time...



"Today in the Town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord." Luke 2:11

Epiphany the holiday: is a Christian feast day which celebrates the revelation of God in human form in the person of Jesus Christ. It falls on January 6th and is observed Sunday, January 8th. This commemorates the visitation of the Magi to the Messiah.

Epiphany the feeling: is the sudden realization or comprehension of the larger essence of something. In ancient Greek, epiphaneia, "manifestation, striking appearance". The feeling one has when they find the last piece of the puzzle and now sees the whole picture!

We celebrate Epiphany (the holiday) on January 6th, which means a sign from God breaking into our world and doing something. The Wise Men followed the star to the birth place of the Messiah. The manifestation of Christ to the world, the Mystery of the Incarnation. Western Christianity observes a twelve day festival, starting December 25, and ending January 6, known as Christmastide or the Twelve Days of Christmas.

In The Hole in Our Gospel, Richard Stearns urges readers to ask the question, "What if?" YOUNG ADULT MISSION & MINISTRY

Young Adult Volunteer Kirt Gibbs (from PC USA) Miami, Fla.

You wouldn't know it by hearing him speak, but Buffalo, N.Y., native Kirt Gibbs is not what most people would think of when envisioning the "typical" PC(USA) Young Adult Volunteer (YAV). Most YAVs are born and raised Presbyterian, but it wasn't until college that Kirt's personal convictions led him to be baptized as a Presbyterian. Not only has Kirt embraced our Church, he is passionately demonstrating Christ's love as a Young Adult Volunteer in Miami, Florida.

Currently, YAVs are tasked with raising a large portion of their own support funds: "Raising the money is hard. ... But ... this is an amazing experience. It's beyond simply doing a good deed. It's literally changing [social] structures, our world views, and people."

Being driven by his passion for others, Kirt plans to attend seminary and work in full-time ministry once his current YAV stint is finished. As positive as his experience has been, he also recognizes the financial obstacles that may prevent others from following the same path—and how you can help: "When you donate to YAVs like me, you're helping to raise future leaders for Presbyterian congregations. ... You're [helping] people who care about people come forward and make a difference."

The PCJH Mission team responded by making a generous year-end gift that will help ease the burden faced by those young adults who wish to serve our Church and our Lord.
