ANNUAL PLEDGE SUNDAY - NOVEMBER 18TH

As you probably know, Annual Pledge Sunday, November 18, is fast approaching. The Annual Fund is what PCJH relies upon to cover our operating and programmatic costs. The Pledge Forms will be inserted in the Sunday bulletins on Nov 11th and the 18th. The list of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) regarding this year's Stewardship campaign will be available in the Church lobby.

This year's Stewardship Campaign entitled, "With a Grateful Heart" focuses on <u>participation</u>. The Sunday before Annual Pledge Sunday – November 11th – has been designated "With a Grateful Heart Sunday." We will ask you to write down what you are grateful for and then post them around the Sanctuary or Chapel walls. We plan to summarize the results and announce them on November 18th.

We would like everyone this year to complete a Pledge Form and indicate one of three ways to record your pledge: (1) a percentage contribution which was emphasized in the Old Testament, and/or (2) a specific dollar amount representing a "portion" of what God has given you as added in the New Testament, and/or (3) a commitment to "give when you can."

PCJH's overall mission is to "Pass on the Faith." To achieve that objective our Church offers a wide variety of ministry and mission (outreach) projects, such as three weekly worship services, community dinners on Wednesday evening, ongoing adult Bible studies, children's Sunday school, Little Lambs pre-school, Upward Basketball, JOY University in the summer, and Agros International to name but a few. Each of these high-impact programs change the lives of those that participate.

To participate in this year's Stewardship Campaign, we encourage you to:

First, prayerfully consider what God is calling you to contribute to His work through the Presbyterian Church of Jackson Hole.

Second, complete the Annual Fund Pledge Form for 2013 and encourage others in the congregation to do the same.

Third, present the Pledge Form on Annual Pledge Sunday, November 18th or mail it to the Church office.

Thank you once again for your past support of God's work through PCJH. May God bless your considerations for the coming year.

It is always good to take a step back and evaluate how we are doing in our mission of Passing on the Faith. The above list contains many of the things that we've shared. For these ministries and missions we can say "Hallelujah!!" They are effective tools through which we are fulfilling God's call on our congregation's life.

On Sunday, November 11, you will have an opportunity to add your "Hallelujahs" to this list during worship. How has God used PCJH's ministry to touch you, challenge you, shape you, encourage you, and support you? There is so much for which we can be thankful. The specifics will help us shape our time of worship on November 18 as we "Give Thanks with a Grateful Heart."

In the midst of sharing our joys that take place in and through our ministry and mission, there is a question that continues to sit in the back of my mind:

Does PCJH make disciples?

By design, PCJH is a "Program Church." This is a technical term used in church circles over the past 30+ years and is reflective of us. A program church is a church that attempts to reach and grow disciples of Jesus Christ by providing many opportunities where people can worship, study, and serve. I hear how busy we are from many people:

- † My 93 year old mother who faithfully reads the Pinnacle:
- † Del Ray on the radio;
- † Visitors who compare us to their home church experience;
- † Church Leaders.

But are we making disciples of Jesus Christ? As I read the Great Commission in the Bible, Matthew 28:19, Jesus said:

As you are going into all the world, make disciples of all people, baptizing them...

Jesus didn't say, 'make programs.' From my pastoral perspective, programs are ultimately successful when they are tools by which people of all ages grow as disciples of Jesus Christ. Growing disciples (even though it is extremely difficult to measure) is my measure of success. It is why I became a pastor. It is what my heart desires.

Advent is the time within the church year when we begin following Jesus. We remember that God so loved the world he became part of our world as a little baby, just like we do and then he grew to become and do everything that God had designed. That is what being a disciple is all about: following Jesus and becoming everything God designed us to be.

Discipleship will be the focus of PCJH during the 1st half of next year. Begin thinking about what it means to you. As we thank God for what has been accomplished, let's also prayerfully prepare for everything God wants us to become.

Digging Deeper into Sunday's Sermon


