High School Mission Trip



Our High School Mission Team left Jackson on Saturday, June 14 through Sunday, June 22 with 19 people from our church Family (13 youth and 6 adult leaders), and headed to Crow Agency, Montana. Our team left to go there to serve, pray and love over the people of the Crow Nation. We did it through 3 different types of ministries; children/youth, practical, and sports. Monday through Thursday morning's we divided into two groups and had two Vacation Bible Schools for the kids at two different churches within the Reservation. It was truly a blessed time to spend with the Crow kids. For our VBS we taught, played games, created crafts based around some Names of God. We also did practical ministry- meeting the needs of the people.

We built a fence at a foster home; painted houses; helped demolish a house; and helped people train horses. We also had a chance to go play basketball with the older Crow Nation youth. They love basketball and play almost every night, unless it is raining. So yes, we did all of these programs, but we as a team and greater, we as a church family, aren't about working for the programs but having the programs work for us. We were, and still are, focused on building relationships with the Crow Nation. That was our focus and prayer for the whole week; building relationships with them through Christ's love and sacrifice. The Native American Reservations are everything you think they are and when you see what you think you are going to see, it is hard to look at. We saw brokenness, poverty, and destruction. However, on the inside of the people's heart we saw hope, fullness and joy. The people of the Crow Nation worship God for one reason. They lift their hands, and they worship Jesus because He exists. No more, no less, just because He exists. When we saw them worshipping, it was truly unbelievable, and it felt so alive. God is definitely working there: He has and He will continue. We, as a team, grew extremely close, and many of the older kids who have been on a few mission trips through our church said, "This has been the best one [mission trip] ever."; "This is the first time we truly became and felt like a family. That has never happened before."; and "This is the first mission trip that I feel like it's not about me but about serving for God." We want to thank our PCJH family for praying for us! Thank you for your donations! Thank you for your support! And once again, thank you for your prayers. We greatly appreciated and needed them! Our youth are hungry and thirsty for the Lord so please pray for them.

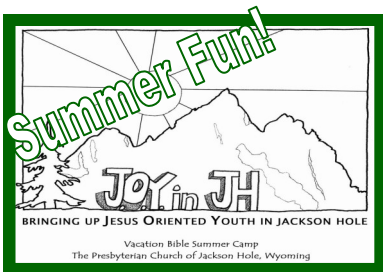

2014 Home Furnishings Sale

Another Success

Through the extraordinary generosity of a number of families and the concerted efforts of 47 dedicated volunteers, the Church netted about \$8,000 at the fifth annual Home Furnishings Sale, held in the Fellowship Hall on Saturday, May 31st.

Furniture and furnishings were donated to the Church throughout the past year, and were stored in storage units until the sale. Additionally, we had many items donated during the week of the sale which were delivered directly to the Church for the sale.

Because of the success of last year's new idea, we again held a "sale preview" on Friday night. We started it earlier than last year (5pm) and it drew over 130 people. Many of these people returned early on Saturday morning to buy the items they had identified on Friday.

On Saturday morning, the Church Fellowship Hall looked very full and drew a crowd of nearly 450 shoppers. Sales activity was fast and furious when the doors opened at 9am. Most all the items were sold within the first 2 hours—over half the items in the first 30 minutes.

With the help of Mountain Movers, a team of 47 volunteers moved the furniture and other sale items into the Fellowship Hall, arranged them for ease of sale, assisted in the sale process, collected the money, moved items into the buyers' vehicles, and cleaned up the Church after the event.

Overall, the event was a great success. Thanks to all who volunteered, donated goods for the sale, and purchased the items to make this fifth annual event so successful.
