ENROLLMENT

Cancellations made after April 30th, 2015 are subject to the following policy: Cancellations will be refunded only if the opening can be filled, minus a \$5.00 per day processing fee. PAYMENTS

A \$50 non-refundable enrollment fee per camper is required at the time of registration. Payment is required with registration. Two options are offered for payments: pay in full at the time of registration or pay 50% at registration and the remaining balance by May 31st. Remaining balances not paid by May 31st will be processed on the first business day in June with the credit card you have provided online. All other requests for scheduled payments must be made in writing and pre-approved by the Summer Camp Director, Diane McGee.
