### Every Member a Minister

#### Dear PCJH Family,

"Outside of the cross of Jesus Christ, there is no hope in this world. That cross and resurrection at the core of the Gospel is the only hope for humanity. Wherever you go, ask God for wisdom on how to get that Gospel in, even in the toughest situations of life."

As we continue along in *The Story* in March we will come to the most important part of God's story as we remember Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection. What Jesus did on the cross and his subsequent resurrection changed history and eternity forever. It also changes our present day lives when we realize what Christ did for us and how He gives us new life. Our past is forgiven, our present is filled with purpose, and our future is secured with God forevermore. This is good news! We will celebrate this central message of our faith during Holy Week, the week leading up to Easter.

#### Holy Week

Palm Sunday is the beginning of Holy Week on March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016. On Palm Sunday we remember Jesus' triumphal and humble entry into Jerusalem while riding on a donkey. People waved palm branches as a way to welcome him and as a sign of who he was... the Messiah.

The joyous celebration didn't last long. Four days later, one of Jesus' disciples, Judas, betrayed him and arranged for the authorities to arrest him. Maundy Thursday is the day we remember Jesus' Last Supper with his disciples and the night he was betrayed and taken away. This all happened late in the evening while Jesus was praying in the Garden of Gethsemane, and while his disciples dosed off.

Good Friday is the day we remember Jesus being crucified on the cross. It is a day of mourning and darkness as we remember the horrible suffering and death he endured on our behalf.

Saturday is a day in between death and resurrection. It reminds us of the reality of sin and death in our world as we await the hope of new life.


Easter Sunday is the day we remember Jesus rising from the dead. It is a day of celebration and joy as we proclaim the good news of the resurrection. Jesus said, "Behold, I am making all things new!" Amen! I encourage you all to not let Holy Week slip by this year. We are often tempted to simply go from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday, without taking time to consider the cost of the cross. Take some intentional time to engage in the story of Jesus Christ and what he did for humanity... what he did for *you*. Like every year, we will provide you with many opportunities to make Holy Week a transformational week in your life. Now it's up to you... here is the schedule for PCJH as we celebrate Holy Week in 2016...

- <u>Palm Sunday, March 20<sup>th</sup></u>, at 8:00am and 10:15am at PCJH. This will also be Confirmation Sunday for our seven confirmation students and their families.
- <u>Maundy Thursday, March 24<sup>th</sup></u> at 7:00pm at Shepherd of the Mountains Lutheran Church down the street. This is a joint ecumenical service with our Lutheran friends as they graciously host us.
- <u>Good Friday, March 25<sup>th</sup></u>, we will all have the opportunity to do a self-guided meditative walk through the **Stations of the Cross** in the Sanctuary anytime from 9:00am to 7:00pm. The Stations of the Cross is a way to remember the journey Christ took to Calvary. It takes at least 15 to 20 minutes to walk through the stations. I would recommend at least 30 minutes. Come anytime between 9:00am and 7:00pm, no appointments necessary, just come on by. At 7:00pm we will host a Good Friday service in the PCJH Chapel. Our Lutheran friends will be joining us for this service as we host them.
- <u>Easter Sunday, March 27<sup>th</sup></u>, there will be an Easter Sunrise Service at the summit of the gondola at Jackson Hole Mountain Resort. The gondola will begin loading at 6:15am and the service will start at 6:45am. The resort will be passing out free sight-seeing tickets and all guests will be required to download after the service. We will also have our regular Easter celebration of worship at 8:00am and 10:15am at PCJH. The 10:15am service will feature some wonderful special music with our choir and a string ensemble. It will be a beautiful day as we celebrate the hope we have in Christ!



### ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING EASTER SUNDAY - March 27, 2016




