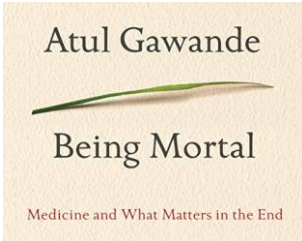
Associate Pastor Nominating Committee Update
