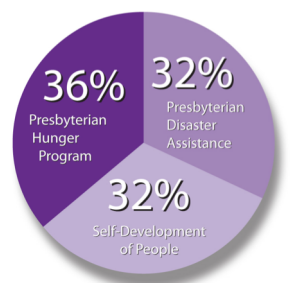

Holy Yoga is Returning

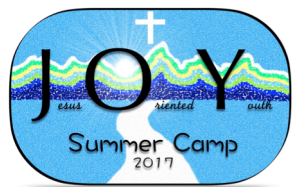

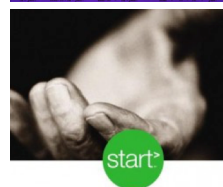
