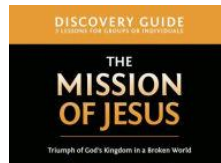

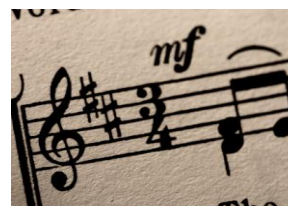
### JOY After School
