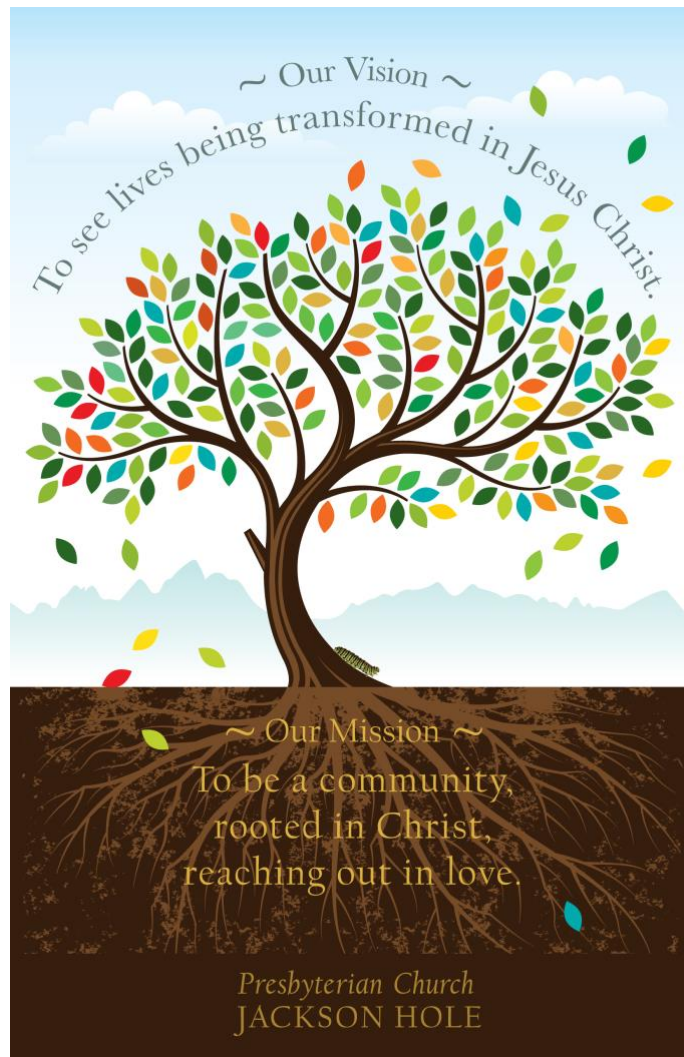

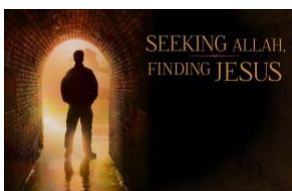
Parents' Night Out
